1. [Holland codes career tests](#)

Holland Codes are a popular model of career testing, based on the premise that the work you enjoy doing is closely related to your personality. See how you rate in the six codes related to career.

2. [Jung typology test](#)

Based on the work of Carl Jung and Isabel Briggs Myers, this test will give you a four-letter type of formula along with the strengths of preferences and the description of your personality type. You can also discover careers and occupations most suitable for your personality type.

3. [Disc personality test](#)

This test lets you determine your DISC type and personality profile quickly. Find out how the DISC factors—Dominance, Influence, Steadiness and Compliance—predict your behavior towards others and the everyday things you do.

4. [The Big Five project personality test](#)

The Big Five is based on the premise that most human personality traits can be boiled down to five broad dimensions of personality, regardless of language or culture. See your results on a colourful scale.
