



DELIVERING CDLF - a step-by-step guide

It starts with reviewing guidelines and learning needs, and ends with reporting.

Read 2023 CDLF Guidelines

And consult with your Regional Office to confirm CDLF workshop.

2

Review BI on global LNA results

Consider conducting a Learning Needs Assessment (LNA) of your own if the results are not representative of the number of serving volunteers.


3

Validate LNA results with Host Entities (HE)

- Align the thematic area of CDLF workshop with HE priorities and secure buy-in including financial contributions.
- Demonstrate UNV's value-added services in supporting HE mandate through volunteer learning.


4

Submit your CDLF proposal online

minimum 4-8 weeks in advance. Get support from CDT and RO on learning objectives, budget estimate, and measurement indicators. These guide the design and delivery to optimize learning outcomes for volunteers.

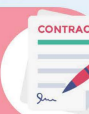
CDT reviews and approves

your CDLF proposal within 1 week of submission, providing guidance to refine the proposal, if necessary.


6

Secure a trainer and workshop venue

Ask RO and HE for verified local trainers. Also check with CDT to deliver workshops on available thematic areas. Work with UNDP procurement to contract services.


7

Design an impactful workshop

- with your verified trainer, utilizing sample workshop templates and guides as references.
- Submit finalized workshop agenda to CDT two weeks prior to workshop.


8

Deliver an inclusive workshop

Invite HE as resource persons and observers to create an opportunity to engage in meaningful partnerships while enabling volunteer learning. Ask CDT to set-up online registration for reporting.


9

Submit your CDLF results

- online within 4 weeks upon completion of the CDLF workshop.
- Customize standard evaluation templates to include your CDLF objectives in advance.
- Ask CDT to set-up online evaluation for reporting.
