# GUIDANCE ON APPLYING FOR UNLPE





#### 1) CHECK YOUR ELIGIBILITY

- Serving UN Volunteers (except UN University Volunteers and UN Community Volunteers) may apply for UNLPE 2023 visit <u>eCampus</u> for detailed info.
- Review <u>HR Portal</u> for process, timeline and eligibility criteria.

#### 2) COLLECT SUPPORTING DOCUMENTS

- Proof of <u>language proficiency</u> or a duly signed <u>Certification of Language Use at Work;</u>
- UN Identity / security card;
- Latest PAF (Personal Action Form) from <u>UVP</u>. Or <u>Letter for Extension of Contract</u> beyond the written exam date, if your current contract expires earlier.



#### 3) REGISTER FOR UNLPE (JUN 5-23, 2023)

- Visit <u>HR Portal</u> and follow <u>instructions to register</u> on Inspira if you haven't already.
- Watch this <u>video</u> on how to apply for UNLPE, and follow step-by-step <u>guidelines for UN Volunteers</u>.

## 5) SELECT "GERMANY, BONN-UN VOLUNTEERS"

as your screening center, irrespective of your actual duty station / location / host entity. Selecting a different center could lead to application rejection.

#### 6) INPUT THESE ENTRIES

- Contractual status: Affiliate of a UN entity
- Entity: UNV-Bonn
- Fee-paying Entity: UNV-Bonn
- Correct <u>UNV Roster no / User ID</u>





#### 7) STAY CONNECTED (JUN-JUL 2023)\*

- Local administrators may push-back if they require more information while screening your application.
- Respond ASAP as delays may result in application rejection.

#### 8) DROP YOUR APPLICATION (JUL 2023)\*

If you decide against taking the UNLPE.

UNV will cover the registration fee to facilitate your application. If you later decide not to take the exam without a valid reason, the fee may be recovered from you.





#### 9) CHECK YOUR APPLICATION STATUS (AUG 2023)\*

- See guide on how to check on Inspira.
- Understand your application status information.
- Look out for convocation letter sent via email through Inspira if your application is approved.

#### 10) PREPARE FOR EXAMS (AUG-SEP 2023)\*

- Enroll yourself in online <u>LPE preparation courses</u> offered free of charge in all UN official languages.
- Watch video for more information.
- UNV is unable to cover fees for additional in-person / online language courses.





#### 11) TAKE YOUR EXAMS ONLINE (OCT 2023)

• English: Wed, Oct 4, 2023

• Chinese: Wed, Oct 11, 2023

• Spanish: Wed, Oct 11, 2023

• French: Wed, Oct 18, 2023

Arabic: Wed, Oct 25, 2023Russian: Wed, Oct 25, 2023



### 12) GET YOUR RESULT (MAR-APR 2024)\*

\*Dates are tentative. Keep checking <u>HR Portal</u> for updates and your in-box for the final result.


